

**ADMINISTRATIVE APPROVAL (ASV) ADD2008-00078**

**ADMINISTRATIVE APPROVAL  
LEE COUNTY, FLORIDA**

WHEREAS, Boyd Hippenstiel/Federal Heath Sign Company, in reference to Super Target at Coconut Point, filed an application for administrative approval of a deviation for signage for development of property located at 8040 Mediterranean Drive, described more particularly as:

WHEREAS, the subject property is located in the Coconut Point Regional Mall located along the east side of U.S. 41 at the intersection of Coconut Road, described more particularly as follows:

**LEGAL DESCRIPTION:** In Section 04, Township 47 South, Range 25 East, Lee County, Florida:

See Exhibit "A"

WHEREAS, the applicant has indicated the property's current STRAP number is 04-47-25-36-000SC.0050; and

WHEREAS, the subject property is zoned Mixed Use Planned Development (MPD) and was included in the original rezoning Case Number Z-02-009, DCI2001-00005 and DRI2000-00015 within the Coconut Point Mixed Use Planned Development (MPD) on a 482.4 ± acre parcel permitting a regional mall with 1,800,000 square feet of retail floor area, 300,000 square feet of office floor area, 1,200 dwelling units and 600 hotel units with subsequent amendments; and

WHEREAS, the subject property is located in the Urban Community Future Land Use Category as designated by the Lee Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Super Target, located within Tract 2B of the Coconut Point Regional Mall Parcel, see Exhibit "B", was developed under Case Number DOS2004-00135 and Permit Number COM2005-02889 as a 187,918 ± square-foot building including a grocery store, deli, pharmacy, bakery, garden center, management offices, optical center, Starbucks and other ancillary retail uses; and

WHEREAS, the subject property was granted an Administrative Amendment in Case Number ADD2007-00192, included as Exhibit "C", for a deviation from the Land Development Code (LDC), Section 33-385(8) which permits a maximum of 300 square feet of signage per wall and limits wall signs to the business name and logo to permit an additional 251.75 square feet of building signage, allowing a maximum of 482.25 square feet of signage on the front elevation including "Super Target", bulls eye logo, "Grocery", "Pharmacy", and "Garden Center" and 334.75 square feet of signage including "Super Target" and the bulls eye logo

on the left and right elevations.

WHEREAS, the applicant has requested an Administrative Amendment for a deviation from the Land Development Code (LDC), Section 33-385(8), which would permit a maximum of 1,200 square feet of signage on the Super Target building, consisting of a maximum of 300 square feet per building elevation determined by the sum of all reasonable rectangles that enclose the sign parts; and

WHEREAS, the applicant's request will permit a total of 1,758.50 square feet of building signage, which represents an additional 606.75 square feet as approved in ADD2007-00192 as follows:

- a. Front elevation - Signage will total 684.5 square feet as follows:
  1. "Super Target" with bulls eye consisting of a total of 537 square feet;
  2. "Grocery" consisting of a total of 43 square feet (existing);
  3. "Pharmacy" consisting of a total of 35 square feet (existing);
  4. "Garden Center" consisting of a total of 69.5 square feet (existing)  
(an increase of 202.25 square feet)
- b. Left elevation - "Super Target" with bulls eye consisting of 537 square feet;  
(an increase of 202.25 square feet)
- c. Right elevation - "Super Target" with bulls eye consisting of 537 square feet;  
(an increase of 202.25 square feet)

WHEREAS, the administrative amendment will permit the completion of the business name logo on the front, left and right elevations as depicted on Exhibit "D"; and

WHEREAS, the LDC, Section 30-91(a) establishes measurement of sign area as follows:

"The sign area shall be measured from the outside edges of the sign or the sign frame, whichever is greater, excluding the area of the supporting structures provided that the supporting structures are not used for advertising purposes and are of an area equal to or less than the permitted sign area. In the case of wall signs without a border or frame, the surface area shall include such reasonable and proportionate space as would be required if a border or frame were used."

Therefore, the subject signage, consisting of the words "Super", "Target" and the bulls eye logo, is measured as one unit totaling 537 square feet, in lieu of three individual sign components totaling 334.75 square feet; and

WHEREAS, the Estero Design Review Committee (EDRC), as depicted in a letter

WHEREAS, the subject application and plans have been reviewed by the Lee County Department of Community Development in accordance with applicable regulations for compliance with all terms of the administrative approval; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the location and the square footage of the building, the proposed amendment to permit an increase in the maximum square footage of the "Super Target" signage on three elevations of the building , the following findings of fact are offered:

1. There are no apparent deleterious effects upon the adjoining property owners;
2. The modifications will not have an adverse impact on the public health, safety and welfare; and
3. The modifications will be the minimum required to comply with the LDC, while maintaining the architectural balance intended for the size of the building.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED that the application for Administrative Approval for an amendment to the Coconut Point Mixed Use Planned Development is **APPROVED**, limited to the signage plan stamped received May 21, 2008 and included hereto as Exhibit "D" to allow the following:

**DEVIATIONS:**

1. **Total sign square footage located on the front, left and right elevations must not exceed 1,758.50 square feet as follows:**
2. **Front elevation - Signage totaling 684.5 square feet as follows:**
  - a.
    1. **"Super Target" (includes the words "Super Target" and bulls eye logo) consisting of a total of 537 square feet;**
    2. **"Grocery" consisting of a total of 43 square feet (existing);**
    3. **"Pharmacy" consisting of a total of 35 square feet (existing);**
    4. **"Garden Center" consisting of a total of 69.5 square feet (existing);**
  - b. **Left elevation - "Super Target" (includes the words "Super Target" and bulls eye logo) consisting of a total of 537 square feet.**
  - c. **Right elevation - "Super Target" (includes the words "Super Target" and bulls eye logo) consisting of a total of 537 square feet.**

**CONDITIONS:**

1. **No signage will be permitted on the rear elevation of the building adjacent to Sandy Lane.**

1. No signage will be permitted on the rear elevation of the building adjacent to Sandy Lane.
2. All lighted signage will be turned off at 10:00 p.m. Monday through Sunday.
3. The only changes approved as part of this Administrative Amendment are those approved deviations described above. No other changes have been authorized as part of this amendment and the development must remain in compliance with the terms and conditions of the original zoning resolution (as amended). The Development must be in compliance with the Master Concept Plan (as amended). The Development must be substantially consistent with the attached five-page signage plan stamped received May 21, 2008.
4. All other signs within this development must be consistent with the Land Development Code (LDC), Sections 30 and 33, except as specifically modified and approved within this action.
5. The terms and conditions of the original zoning resolution remain in full force and effect.

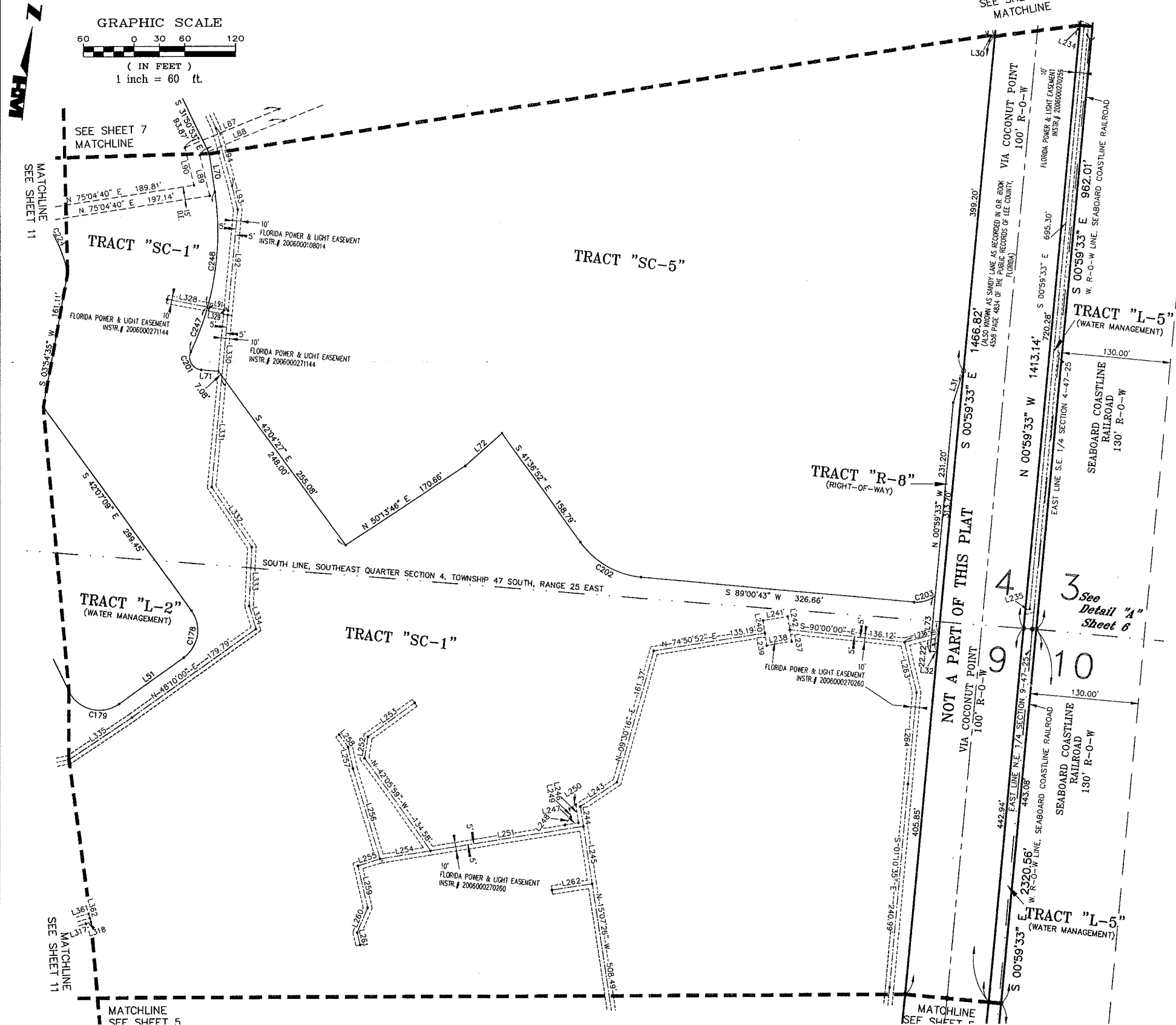

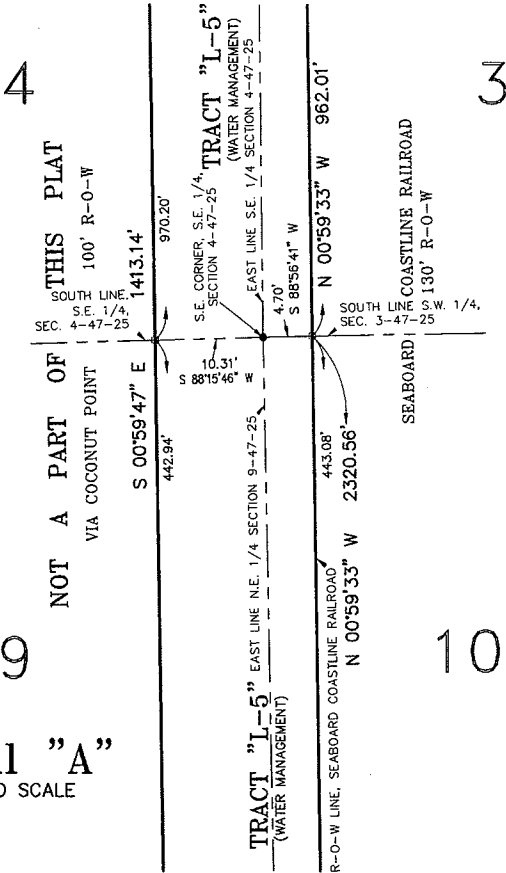

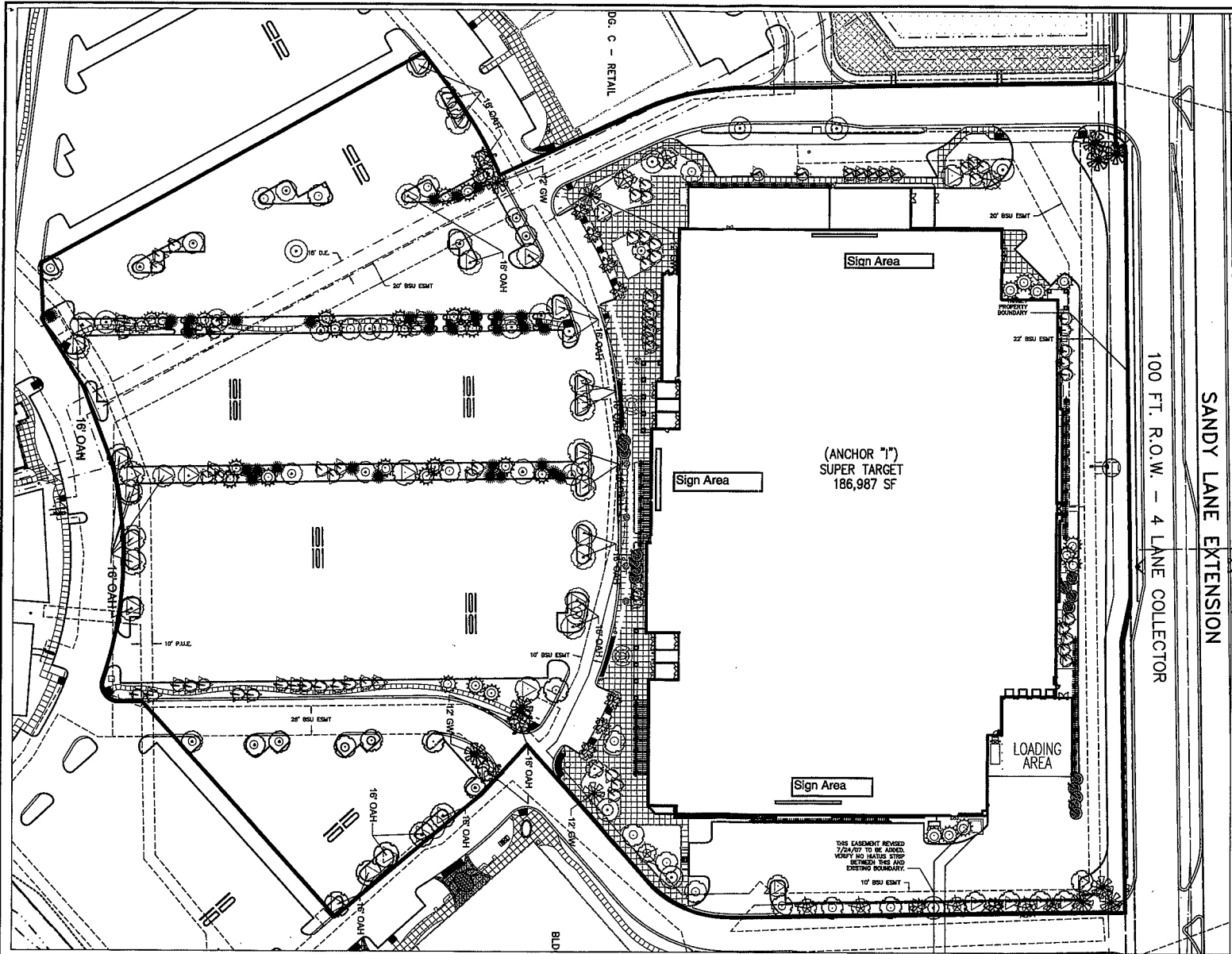

#### ADMINISTRATIVE AMENDMENT LEE COUNTY, FLORIDA

WHEREAS, Dennis Toner c/o Colite International, filed an application for administrative approval to a Mixed Use Planned Development on a project known as Coconut Point for the property located at 8040 Mediterranean Drive, Estero; and

WHEREAS, the subject property is located in the Coconut Point Regional Mall located along the east side of U.S. 41 at the intersection of Coconut Road, described more particularly as follows:

LEGAL DESCRIPTION: See "Attachment A".

WHEREAS, the subject property was included in the original rezoning Case Number Z-02-009, DCI2001-00005 and DRI2000-00015 within the Coconut Point Mixed Use Planned Development (MPD) on a 482.4(+)-acre parcel permitting a regional mall with 1,800,000 square feet of retail floor area, 300,000 square feet of office floor area, 1,200 dwelling units and 600 hotel units (with subsequent amendments in Case Numbers DRI2004-00003, ADD2004-00060(A), ADD2004-00060(B), ADD2004-00048, ADD2004-00206, ADD2005-00011, ADD2004-00187, ADD2005-00026, ADD2005-00080, ADD2005-00122, ADD2005-00177, ADD2005-00233, ADD2004-00060(C), COP2006-00035, ADD2006-00024, ADD2006-00011, ADD2006-00119, ADD2006-00143, COP2006-00121, ADD2006-00168, COP2006-00150, COP2006-00176, COP2006-00169, DRI2006-00002, COP2006-00176(A), COP2006-00169(A), COP2006-00121(A), COP2006-00035(A), COP2006-00150(B), ADD2007-00028, ADD2007-00087 and ADD2007-00016; and

WHEREAS, the subject property is located in the Rural and Wetlands Future Land Use Category as designated by the Lee Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Super Target, located within Tract 2B of the Coconut Point Regional Mall Parcel, see Attachment "B", is being developed under Case Number DOS2004-00135 and Permit Number COM2005-02889 as a 187,918 (+) square-foot building including a grocery store, deli, pharmacy, bakery, garden center, management offices, optical center, Starbucks and other ancillary retail uses; and

WHEREAS, the applicant has requested an Administrative Amendment to permit additional signage which will provide a service to the public by displaying additional uses located within the building; and

WHEREAS, Super Target is requesting a sign package, see Attachment "C", totaling 1,151.75 square feet, which exceeds the maximum permitted signage of 900 square feet by 251.75 square feet, to be located on three (3) elevations of the building; and

WHEREAS, Super Target is requesting deviations from the Land Development Code (LDC), Section 33-385(8) which permits wall signs on any wall facing a collector or arterial

street or parking lot in accordance with Section 30-153(2)(c)1, with a maximum area of 300 square feet per wall per tenant. This area is to be determined by the sum of all reasonable rectangles that enclose the sign parts. Wall signs are limited to business name and logo, and may not contain advertising messages or sales item names, as follows:

- a. Front elevation - Signage totaling 482.25 square feet as follows:
  - 1. "Super Target" consisting of 334.75 square feet;
  - 2. "Grocery" consisting of 43 square feet;
  - 3. "Pharmacy" consisting of 35 square feet; and
  - 4. "Garden Center" consisting of 69.5 square feet
- b. Left elevation - "Super Target" signage totaling 334.75 square feet; and
- c. Right elevation - "Super Target" signage totaling 334.75 square feet.

WHEREAS, Each proposed "Super Target" sign faces a county-maintained collector or a parking lot; and

WHEREAS, Simon Property Group, representing Super Target, has presented the signage deviation request to the Estero Design Review Committee (EDRC) on three (3) separate occasions, June 13, 2007, August 8, 2007 and October 10, 2007, (See minutes attached as "D"), who approved the request subject to conditions incorporated within this Administrative request; and

WHEREAS, Lee County Land Development Code provides for certain administrative changes to planned development master concept plans and planned unit development final development plans; and

WHEREAS, the subject application and plans have been reviewed by the Lee County Department of Community Development in accordance with applicable regulations for compliance with all terms of the administrative approval procedures; and

WHEREAS, it is found that, in accordance with the location and the square footage of the building, the proposed amendment to permit an increase in the maximum square footage of the "Super Target" signage on three (3) elevations of the building or the additional signage depicting "Grocery", "Pharmacy", and "Garden Center" located on the front elevation does not increase density or intensity within the development; does not decrease buffers or open space required by the LDC; does not underutilize public resources or infrastructure; does not reduce total open space, buffering, landscaping or preservation areas; and does not otherwise adversely impact on surrounding land uses.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED that the application for administrative approval for an amendment to the Coconut Point Mixed Use Planned Development is **APPROVED** to allow:

**DEVIATIONS:**

1. A deviation from the Land Development Code, Section 33-386(8) which permits a maximum area of 300 square feet of signage per wall and limits wall signs to the business name and logo to permit an additional 251.75 square feet of signage as follows:
  - a. Front elevation - Signage totaling 482.25 square feet as follows:
    1. "Super Target" consisting of a total of 334.75 square feet;
    2. "Grocery" consisting of a total of 43 square feet;
    3. "Pharmacy" consisting of a total of 35 square feet; and
    4. "Garden Center" consisting of a total of 69.5 square feet
  - b. Left elevation - "Super Target" signage totaling 334.75 square feet; and
  - c. Right elevation - "Super Target" signage totaling 334.75 square feet.

**CONDITIONS:**

1. No signage will be permitted on the rear elevation of the building adjacent to Sandy Lane.
2. All lighted signage will be turned off at 10:00 p.m. Monday through Sunday.
3. Additional sabal palms will be incorporated into the front elevation perimeter as agreed upon by the applicant and the EDRC (in accordance with Minutes from the June 13, 2007 meeting) to be reviewed and approved by the Lee County Division of Environmental Sciences.
4. The only changes approved as part of this Administrative Amendment are those approved deviations described above. No other changes have been authorized as part of this amendment and the development must remain in compliance with the terms and conditions of the original zoning resolution (as amended). The Development must be in compliance with the Master Concept Plan (as amended). The Development must be substantially consistent with the attached five (5)-page signage plan stamped received October 31, 2007.
5. All other signs within this development must be consistent with the Land Development Code Chapters 30 and 33, except as specifically approved within this action.

6. The terms and conditions of the original zoning resolution remain in full force and effect.


The above referenced project was presented to the EDRC on Oct. 10, 2007 and has satisfied the public informational session as required per LDC, Sect. 34-1042. The EDRC reviewed the submittal and discussed the signage and landscaping design documents. At the EDRC meeting held on May 14, 2008, the undersigned was authorized to modify this letter to further clarify signage recommendation for approval.

**Comments:**

The EDRC reviewed the proposed signage presented for the Super Target store in Coconut Point. The applicant presented a drawing indicating among other things that the signage at the front of the building exceeded the area allowed in the LDC. During discussions, the applicant agreed to eliminate the lighted sign on the rear of the building and to increase the planting of trees at the front of the building. In doing so the front signage was seen as quite acceptable in size as presented. The committee agreed to support the excess signage as submitted on the drawings.
