Development of Regional Impact Related Comprehensive Plan Amendment

Dear Mr. Eubanks:

In accordance with the provisions of <u>F.S.</u> Chapter 163.3187(1)(b) and of 9J-11.006, this submission package constitutes the adoption of an amendment to the Lee Plan known locally as CPA 2010-02 - University Highlands (Amendment 10-D2). The proposed amendment is one of the exemptions to the twice per calendar year limitation on the adoption of comprehensive plan amendments, due to the fact that it is directly related to a proposed Development of Regional Impact, the Timberland and Tiburon DRI. The Board of County Commissioners adoption hearing for the plan amendment was held on October 18, 2010 starting at 9:30 am. The Board of County Commissioners voted to adopt the Lee Plan amendment package at the October 18, 2010 hearing by Ordinance 10-33, which is included with this transmittal package.

The adopted amendment will: amend Map 1 of the Lee Plan Future Land Use Map Series to change the future land use category of a 208.4-acre parcel at the southwest corner of Ben Hill Griffin Parkway and Estero Parkway from Suburban to Urban Community; amend Policy 1.1.4 to Limit bonus density to Transfer Development Rights; and add the site to the Mixed Use Overlay.

Staff has addressed the concerns discussed in the ORC report with additional analysis as requested by DCA. Also included, per F.S. 163.3184(7) and (15), is the required sign-in form allowing a courtesy informational statement to interested citizens. The name of the local newspaper in which the Notice of Intent should be published is The News-Press, Fort Myers, Florida.
