**Subject:** CPA2010-00004 (Villages of Pine Island)

Planning staff is asking for your help in reviewing the above referenced proposed amendment to the Lee Plan.

CPA2010-00004 is a privately initiated Lee County Comprehensive Plan amendment known as "Villages of Pine Island".

The Villages of Pine Island Plan amendment proposes to identify the property within the Future Sewer Service Area shown on Map 7 of the Lee Plan. The subject site is 76.06 acres in size and has an approved Development Order that permits 480 multi-family residential dwelling units, and 49,800 square feet of commercial uses. A Minor Change to the Development Order was approved on February 12, 2007 in order to provide a connection to the Lee County sewer system rather than to construct an individual treatment plant. In order for the Lee County Utilities to accept the sewage flow, Map 7 must be amended to include the subject property within the Future Sewer Service Area. The proposed amendment to Map 7 of the Lee Plan would not change the allowable densities or intensities of the subject site.

Please review the application for CPA2010-00004 (a link is provided below), and provide sufficiency comments which address the completeness of the application and identify any missing information that is needed to provide a complete review. Comments should be provided no later than July 29, 2010.
