

Boat Ramps

Lee County Parks and Recreation desired non-regulatory level of service is 1 boat ramp lane with adequate parking per 35,000 population of the entire county. The Lee County population in 2009 was 613,546. So the desired standard is to provide $613,546*/35,000 = 17$ boat ramp lanes desired. Lee County currently provides 13 boat ramp lanes with adequate parking as well as two additional small watercraft launches without trailer parking. Combined with the Federal (2 Ramps 3 Lanes), State (3 Ramps 5 Lanes) & Municipal (8 Ramps 13 Lanes) boat ramp facilities Lee County has a total of 22 ramps with 34 boat ramp lanes. Below is a table of the boat ramps and lanes provided at each Lee County boat ramp facility.
