In accordance with the provisions of F.S. Chapter 163, this submission package constitutes the adoption of the Comprehensive Plan Amendment known locally as CPA2011-22, a Lee County Sponsored Amendment. The Lee County Board of County Commissioners held an adoption hearing for this plan amendment on June 17, 2013 starting at 9:30 a.m.

This amendment packet includes the final action and adopting ordinance for CPA 2011-22 (Port Authority Hazardous Wildlife Update). The changes in the proposed amendment are identical to the changes that were transmitted by the Lee County Board of County Commissioners for state review on March 4, 2013. As required by F.S. 163.3184, the final action on this amendment was completed within 180 days of the receipt of the State Land Planning Agency's review letter.
