Those statutes eliminated mandatory concurrency requirements for Transportation, Parks and Recreation Facilities, and Public Schools. In the case of transportation, the law has been changed to limit the circumstances and degree by which local governments can impose mitigation on developers. The state has also enacted legislation that prohibits local governments from imposing DRI review on development that does not exceed the statutory thresholds for DRI's. The first proposed amendment will remove policies in the Lee Plan that require development within the University Community land use category to undergo DRI review regardless of whether the proposed project exceeds DRI thresholds. The second amendment will revise the concurrency requirements for Transportation, Parks and Recreation Facilities, and Public Schools. The third amendment will update Map 3(f) of the Lee Plan to reflect the revised Airport Layout Plan approved by
