This letter is in response to your request dated October 7, 2011 for the Alico Air Park for sufficiency comments in reference to the educational impact. This proposed structure is located in the South Choice Zone, Sub Zone S2.

The Developers request states there is a possibility of 800 Multi-family units. With regard to the inter-local agreement for school concurrency the generation rates are created from the type of dwelling unit and further broken down by grade level.

For multi-family the generation rate is .118 and further broken down into the following, .059 for elementary, .028 for middle and .030 for high. A total of 93 school-aged children would be generated and utilized for the purpose of determining sufficient capacity to serve the development. Currently within the School District there are sufficient seats available to serve this need.
