NOTICE OF PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE LEE COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE LAND USE PLAN

On Thursday, August 30, 2007, the Lee County Board of Commissioners will hold a public hearing to consider amending the Lee County Comprehensive Land Use Plan (Lee Plan). The hearing will be held in the Board of County Commissioners' Chambers in the renovated Courthouse at 2120 Main Street in Downtown Fort Myers. The hearing will commence at 9:30 a.m., or as soon thereafter as may be heard. The nature of the proposed Lee Plan amendment is as follows:

- 1. Amend the maps and various elements of the Lee Plan to accommodate development proposed in the Application for Development Approval for the Fountains DRI. The subject of the proposed amendment to the Lee Plan encompasses 2,769 +/- acres of property generally located at the intersection of Daniels Parkway and S.R. 82.
 - a. Incorporate a new Goal, Objective, and Policies that are specific to the "Town Center District" into the Future Land Use Element.
 - b. Incorporate several new definitions into the Glossary.
 - c. Amend the Future Land Use Map series, Map 1, to change the Future Land Use Classification shown on Map 1 from "Density Reduction/Groundwater Resource," "Central Urban," and "Wetlands" to "Density Reduction/Facilities," "Conservation Lands," and "Town Center District." Incorporate a new map into the Future Land Use Map Series to be known as Map 1A, the "Town Center District Map." Amend Map 3D, "Unincorporated Bikeways/Walkways Facilities Plan"; Map 3I, "Public Transit Trip Generators"; Map 4, "Private Recreational Facilities Overlay Map"; Map 6, "Lee County Utilities Future Water Service Areas"; Map 7, "Lee County Utilities Future Sewer Service Areas"; Map 16, "Lee County Planning Communities"; Map 19, "Commercial Site Location Standards Map"; and Map 20, "Contiguous Agricultural Parcels Over 100 acres in Non Urban Future Land Use Categories."
 - d. Amend Table 1(a), Summary of Residential Densities; Table 1(b), Planning Community Year 2030 Allocations.

At the conclusion of the hearing, the Board will vote to transmit, transmit with modifications, or not transmit the proposed Fountains DRI related amendment to the Lee Plan.

The file on the proposed comprehensive plan amendments for the Fountains DRI may be inspected by the public at the Office of the County Attorney, Courthouse Administration Building, 2115 Second Street, 6th Floor, Fort Myers, Florida.

The meeting is open to the public and all interested parties are encouraged to attend. Interested parties may appear and be heard with respect to the proposed

amendments to the Lee Plan. Pursuant to Florida Statutes, persons participating in the Comprehensive Plan Amendment process, who provide their name and address on the record, will receive a courtesy information statement from the Department of Community Affairs (DCA) prior to the publication of the Notice of Intent to find the plan amendment in compliance. If a person decides to appeal the Board's decision, he or she will need a record of the proceedings, and, for such purpose, he or she may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceeding is made, which record includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based.
