The application does not include an analysis of available water supply using the current water use allocation in the consumptive use permit, however, the allocation in LCU's Consumptive Us Permit is sufficient to support the proposed increase demand as a result of this amendment. The application does include an analysis demonstrating that the Corkscrew WTP and the Green Meadows WTP have sufficient capacity to serve the proposed development.

The application does not address existing sanitary sewer infrastructure in the immediate area with the potential to serve the subject property. However, there is an existing 12" sanitary sewer force main at the corner of Michael G. Rippe Pkwy. and S. Tamiami Trail, that could potentially serve as a point of connection to the sanitary sewer collection system. The applicant should be aware that off-site improvements to provide wastewater collection infrastructure, with sufficient capacity to provide service to the site, will likely be required.
☑Improvements/expansions currently programmed in 5 year CIP, 6-10 year CIP, and long range improvements:
The applicant has indicated that the project will be served by the Three Oaks Wastewater Treatment Plant. Improvements to the Three Oaks Wastewater Treatment Plant are programmed in the 5 year CIP. These improvements will provide additional capacity at the Three Oaks WWTP.
