Dear Mr. Drovdlic,

LeeTran has reviewed your request for service availability in regards to a proposed Small-scale Comprehensive Plan Amendment application, on the referenced subject area located approximately on the northeast and northwest corners of Daniels Parkway and Commerce Lakes Drive in the Gateway community in Lee County. After reviewing the site and comparing the location with our existing and planned route locations according to the 2016 Transit Development Plan (TDP), the following has been determined:

- Subject area is not within one-quarter mile of a fixed-route corridor
- Closest fixed-route corridor is the route 50 along Daniels Pkwy going westbound
- The 2016 TDP does not identify the need for enhanced or additional transit services in the area

Proposed future development does not currently meet applicability outlined in Sec. 10-442 and Sec. 10-443. Developer will not be required to connect to and improve transit facilities because pedestrian access from subject parcels to closest stop is greater than one-quarter mile.


If transit services have been modified within one-quarter mile of the subject parcels at time of a DO or LDO type D submittal, necessary improvements will be determined at that time.




LOSA Proposed Development FMBC CPA

Mr. Drovdlic,

The requested Small-Scale Comprehensive Plan Amendment for 22.14 +- acres located on the northeast and northwest corners of Daniels Parkway and Commerce Lakes Drive in the Gateway community in unincorporated Lee County does not affect the ability of the Lee County Sheriff's Office to provide core services at this time.

Therefore, we have no objections to amending the property's Future Land Use Designation from Airport and Wetlands to New Community, which would allow for the option to develop 50 multi-family dwelling units and up to 80,000 square feet of commercial, retail and industrial uses in the pending Fort Myers Brewery Mixed-Use Planned Development.

This agency will provide law enforcement services from our Central District substation in Fort Myers. At the time of application for new development orders or building permits, the applicant shall provide a Crime Prevention Through Environmental Design (CPTED) report done by the applicant and given to the Lee County Sheriff's Office for review and comments. Mr. Drovdlic,

I am in receipt of your letter requesting a Letter of Service Availability for the Small-Scale Comprehensive Plan Amendment for the Fort Myers Brewery MPD.

Lee County Emergency Medical Services is the primary EMS transport agency responsible for coverage at the address you have provided. Because we currently serve this area and have a sufficient response data sample, we evaluated response times in this vicinity to simulate the anticipated demand and response.

The primary ambulance for this location is located 4.3 miles northeast; there is a second EMS station 6.1 miles of the proposed location. These locations are projected to be able to meet existing service standards, as required in County Ordinance 08-16, and no additional impacts are anticipated at this time.

It is our opinion that the service availability for the proposed development of this property is adequate at this time. Should the plans change, especially the density, a new analysis of this impact would be required.

Dear Mr. Droydlic:

The Lee County Solid Waste Department is capable of providing solid waste and recycling collection service for the proposed Fort Myers Brewery MPD project through Lee County's franchised garbage and recycling collection contractor. Disposal of the solid waste from this development will be accomplished at the Lee County Resource Recovery Facility and the Lee-Hendry Regional Landfill. Plans have been made, allowing for growth, to maintain long-term disposal capacity at these facilities.

Please ensure that the project complies with Land Development Code Section 10-261 for sufficient solid waste and recycling container spaces. It is recommended that additional space is set aside for bulky waste items that cannot be disposed of in a dumpster.

Garbage and recycling collections for the multi-family and commercial units require the owner/or the Management Company to secure a service agreement with the County's franchised waste collection contractor, Waste Pro USA, phone (239) 337-0800.

Additionally, Lee County Solid Waste Ordinance 11-27, Section 7 defines commercial establishments and the payment of the annual solid waste assessment levied on the Property Taxes.
