In accordance with the provisions of F.S. Chapter 163.3184(3) for Expedited State Review, please find attached the adopted Comprehensive Plan Amendments, known locally as CPA2020-00004 and CPA2020-00005 (Owl Creek Map and Test Amendments). The amendments are as follows:

CPA2020-00004, Owl Creek (Map):

- Amend the Lee County Utilities Future Water Service Areas (Lee Plan Map 4A) to add property to the Lee County Utilities Future Water Service Area.
- CPA2020-00005, Owl Creek (Text):
- Add a new policy, Policy 29.2.4, to the Lee Plan that provides incentives for preservation or restoration of Rare and Unique Upland Habitats in developments that are located in the North Olga Community Plan area, clustered, and approved through the planned development process.
- Amend Lee Plan Policy 124.1.1 and Table 1(a), Note 8 to allow for the capture of density from preserved wetlands when adjacent to the Rural future land use category.

The Lee County Board of County Commissioners held an adoption hearing to adopt the above identified ordinance for the plan amendment on September 7, 2022. As required by F.S. 163.3184(3)(c)1., the final action on this amendment was completed within 180 days of the receipt of the state land planning agency's report. Both amendments were adopted by Lee County Ordinance #22-25.
