Goal Establish a positive business climate.


Support existing businesses and attraction of new businesses.

Tradeport: Add data centers and education/training facilities; remove redundant environmental best practices requirements.

Industrial Development: Add processing, warehousing, and logistic and data centers

Amendments for consistent treatment of caretakers' residences in the Industrial Development, Tradeport and Commercial future land use categories.

Add language to the Lee Plan to help assure there is adequate land available for employment opportunities as Lee County grows.
