The Lee County Board of County Commissioners will hold a public hearing to consider proposed amendments to the Lee County Comprehensive Land Use Plan (Lee Plan) on Wednesday, January 18, 2023. The hearing will commence at 9:30 a.m., or as soon thereafter as can be heard, in the Board Chambers, 2120 Main Street in Downtown Fort Myers. At the hearing, the Board will consider the proposed amendments for transmittal to the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity: CPA2021-00016 River Hall: Amend the Future Land Use Map designation from Sub-Outlying Suburban to Rural on 11.94 acres; Rural to Sub-Outlying Suburban on 32.4 acres; Sub-Outlying Suburban on 276.63 acres; Rural to Outlying Suburban on 45.68 acres; Sub-Outlying Suburban to Suburban on 22.2 acres with a change in density of +489 units. The subject property is located on the south side of Palm Beach Boulevard (State Road 80), approximately 0.8 miles east of Buckingham Road.

It is the intent of the Board of County Commissioners that the provisions of this Comprehensive Plan Amendment may be modified as a result of consideration that may arise during Public Hearing(s). Such modifications shall be incorporated into the final version.
