I am waiting on Pakorn in LDOT to wrap up his review. I have put him on notice. In the meantime, I have provided you with the Environmental Sciences comment below:

The management plan speaks to SFWMD policies. Please provide language and compliance to management plan requirements following 10-415(b)(4)(f) and 10-474 of the Land Development code.

One of the areas that is changing is the partial release of the CE and the mitigation being required to comply with the indigenous open space as well as the SFWMD requirements. Staff will need management plan information. Please work with Camryn Siverson in order to provide the required documents (copied). Staff is not finding the ADD insufficient but will accept the documents and upload them on behalf of the applicant.

Please keep in mind that I do not have a sign-off from Pakorn in LDOT. There may be more comments.
