Thank you for submitting Lee County's proposed comprehensive plan amendment for our review pursuant to the Expedited State Review process. The reference number for this amendment package is 24-01ESR.

The proposed submission package will be reviewed pursuant to Section 163.3184(3), Florida Statutes. Once the review is underway, you may be asked to provide additional supporting documentation by the review team to ensure a thorough review. You will receive the Department's Comment Letter no later than February 23, 2024.

Pursuant to 163.3184(3)(c)1. If the local government fails, within 180 days after receipt of agency comments, to hold the second public hearing, the amendments shall be deemed withdrawn unless extended by agreement with notice to the state land planning agency and any affected person that provided comments on the amendment.

Pursuant to 163.3184(3)(c)2. All comprehensive plan amendments adopted by the governing body, along with the supporting data and analysis, shall be transmitted within 10 working days after the second public hearing to the state land planning agency and any other agency or local government that provided timely comments under subparagraph (b)2.

In accordance with the provisions of F.S. Chapter 163.3184(3) for Expedited State Review, please find attached the proposed Comprehensive Plan Amendment, known locally as CPA2022-00019 (Cary+Duke+Povia). The amendment is as follows:

CPA2022-00019, Cary+Duke+Povia

Amend Lee Plan Maps 4-A and 4-B to include ±788.97 acres on the Lee County Utilities Future Water and Sewer Service Areas. The property is located on the south side of North River Road, approximately one mile east of the intersection of North River Road and SR 31.

The Local Planning Agency held a public meeting for the plan amendment on September 25, 2023. The Board of County Commissioners voted to transmit the amendment on January 17, 2024. The proposed amendment is not applicable to an area of critical state concern. The Board of County Commissioners stated their intent to hold an adoption hearing following the receipt of the review agencies' comments.
