Enclosed please find responses to Staff's comments dated March 13, 2024. Accordingly, the following items are provided to address Staff's sufficiency review comments:

- 1. Environmental Resource Permit (ERP) Modification Memo;
- 2. Revised Environmental Report;
- 3. Unit 4-B Plat; and
- 4. Title Opinion.

Environmental Comments prepared by: Camryn Silverson:

1. There are hydric FLUCCS located in the areas proposed for expansion. Please indicate how the applicant intends to protect environmental critical areas onsite.

RESPONSE: The applicant will have to obtain an Environmental Resource Permit to address the development and protection of environmental critical areas on site. The applicant requests that the following condition be placed as part of the request which has been placed and approved by the BoCC in other PUD's to address similar staff comments.

"State and Federal Permits

- a. Generally. County development permits do not create rights to obtain permits from state or federal agencies and do not create liability on the part of the County if applicant fails to obtain requisite approvals or fulfill obligations imposed by state/federal agencies or if applicant undertakes actions resulting in a violation of state or federal law. Applicant must obtain applicable state/federal permits prior to commencing development.
- b. State Wetland Permits. Developer may not commence construction on development impacting wetlands until issuance of required state permits. Development activity must comply with state wetland permits and applicable local development permits.

- c. If the State does not approve wetland impacts or if State wetland permits are not consistent with proposed wetland impacts reflected in County development permits, then Developer must amend County development permit approvals consistent with state wetland permits and Lee Plan/LDC regulations on development within wetlands."
- 2. The LDC requires written statement from the entity holding the beneficial interest in the easement, specifying the entity has no objection to the improvements and, improvements will not interfere with the long-term maintenance of the infrastructure within easement area. Please indicate if the expansion of the storage area will impact the FPL easement and if a written statement has been obtained.

RESPONSE: It is noted that staff is amenable to a condition of zoning approval stating that a development order for use of the FPL easement area will not be granted until no objection from FPL is obtained.

 Description & Sketch. Please provide a legal description and sketch in accordance with the requirements of Lee County LDC §34-202(a)(5) Cypress Woods RV Resort Unit 4-B is missing "- B" in the legal description. Please provide a legal description and sketch in accordance with the requirements of Lee County LDC §34-202(a)(5).

RESPONSE: LDC Section 34-202(a)(5) notes that legal descriptions and sketches are not required for platted properties. The plat for Unit 4-B is attached.

- "A metes and bounds legal description along with a sketch of the legal description, prepared by a Florida Licensed Surveyor and Mapper, must be submitted, unless the property consists of one or more undivided lots within a subdivision platted in accordance with F.S. Ch. 177."
- 2. Title Certification. A title certification is required per LDC §34-202(a)(7) and must meet the following criteria:
 - a. Form. The certification of title must be in one of the following forms:
 - i. Title certificate or title opinion, no greater than 90 days old at the time of the initial development order submittal. Or, ii. Title insurance policy with appropriate schedules, no greater than five years old at the time of the initial zoning case submittal and an affidavit of no change covering the period of time between issuance of the policy and the application date.
 - b. Content. The certification of title must include, at a minimum, the following:
 - i. The name of the owner of the fee title.
 - ii. All mortgages secured by the property;
 - iii. All easements encumbering the property;
 - iv. The legal description of the property; and
 - v. The certification of title documentation must be unequivocal.

RESPONSE: Please see attached title opinion.

Zoning Comments: Adam Mendez

1. The Environmental Data report provided includes two erroneous USGS Quad Maps of Lake Harbor, Florida [Pages 4 and 12].

RESPONSE: Please see revised Environmental Report.

2. Please clarify what appears to be a Deviation enumeration "80" on the revised MCP adjacent to the landscape maintenance area access on Luckett Road.

RESPONSE: This enumeration is tied to Deviation 8, allowing for access through a perimeter buffer.

The purpose of this memo is to address comment #1 of the March 13th, 2024, request for additional information. The comment is below:

1. There are hydric FLUCCS located in the areas proposed for expansion. Please indicate how the applicant intends to protect environmental critical areas onsite.

To address potential wetlands in the FPL easement (outside the gravel access road), the applicant will be applying for a modification to their existing environmental resource permit (ERP). The wetland in this area was historically cleared for the FPL easement and is very low quality. My expectation is that the South Florida Water Management District (SFWMD) will request a very small amount of offsite mitigation to be purchased at an approved wetland mitigation bank as part of the permit modification.

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INTRODUCTION

The purpose of this document is to satisfy the Environmental Requirements for Lee County regarding the Master Concept Plan (MCP) Amendment for Cypress Woods (Subject Property).

PROPERTY LOCATION

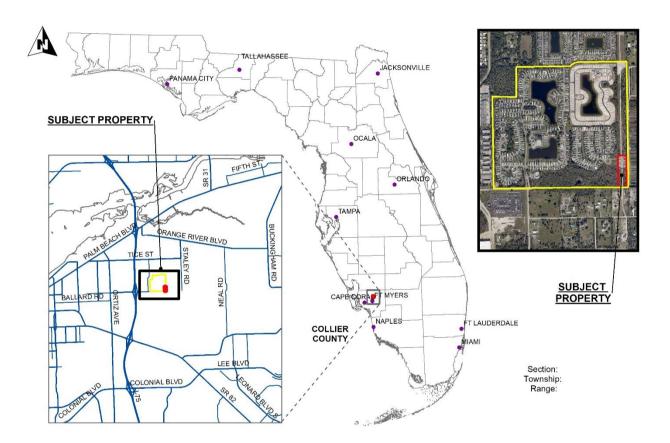


Figure 1. Site Location Map

The Subject Property for this report consists of a portion of a single parcel (Strap # 11-44-25-05-0000K.00CE). The Subject Property is the southern portion of the FPL easement that bisects the Cypress Woods RV Resort development north of Luckett Road and east of I-75 in Lee County, Florida. Based on the boundary linework provided to ETE by the planner the Subject Property totals approximately 2.51 acres. See Figure 1 below for a location map.

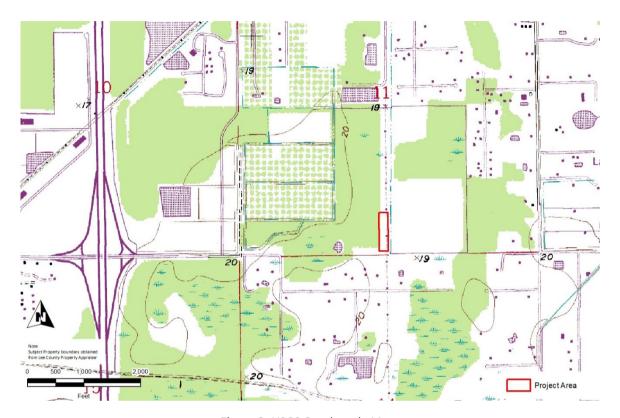


Figure 2. USGS Quadrangle Map

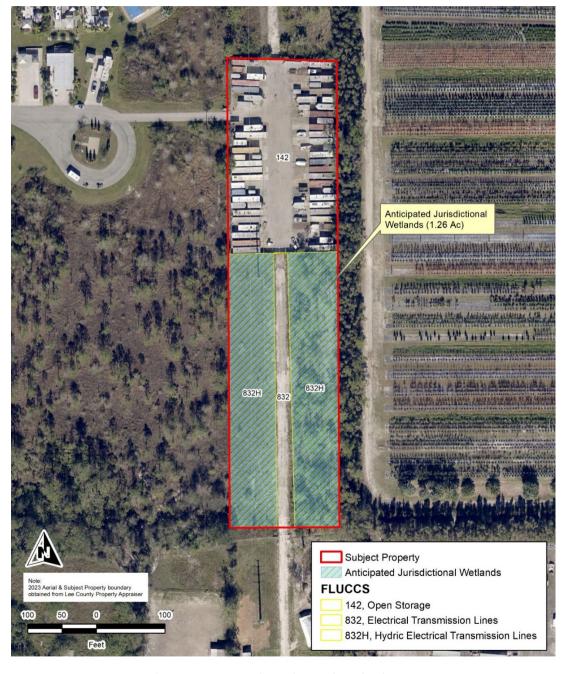


Figure 3. Anticipated Jurisdictional Wetland Map

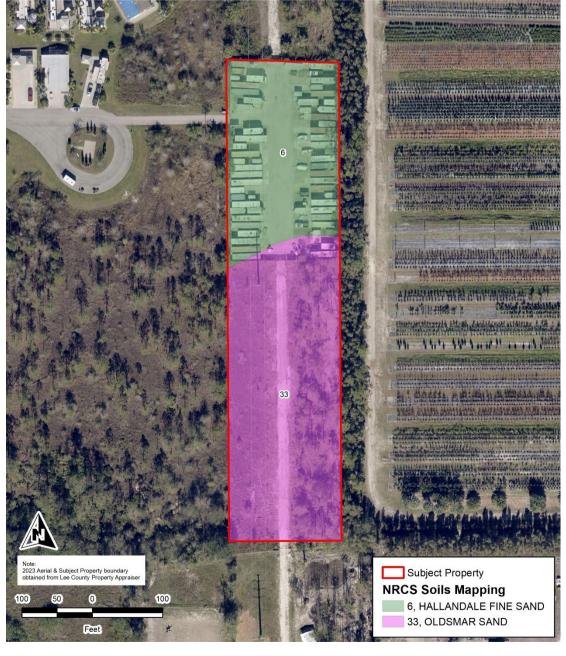


Figure 5. NRCS Soils Map

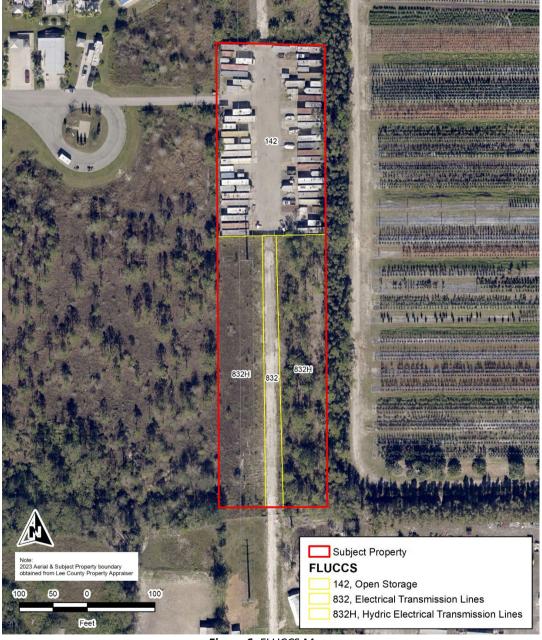


Figure 6. FLUCCS Map

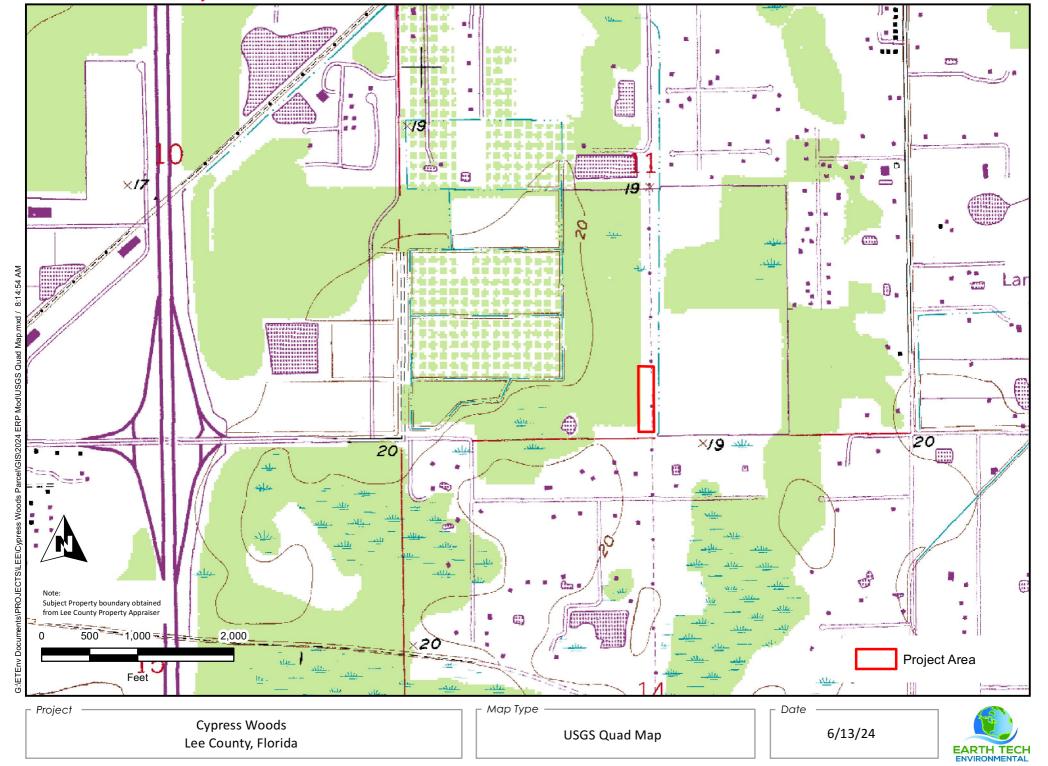

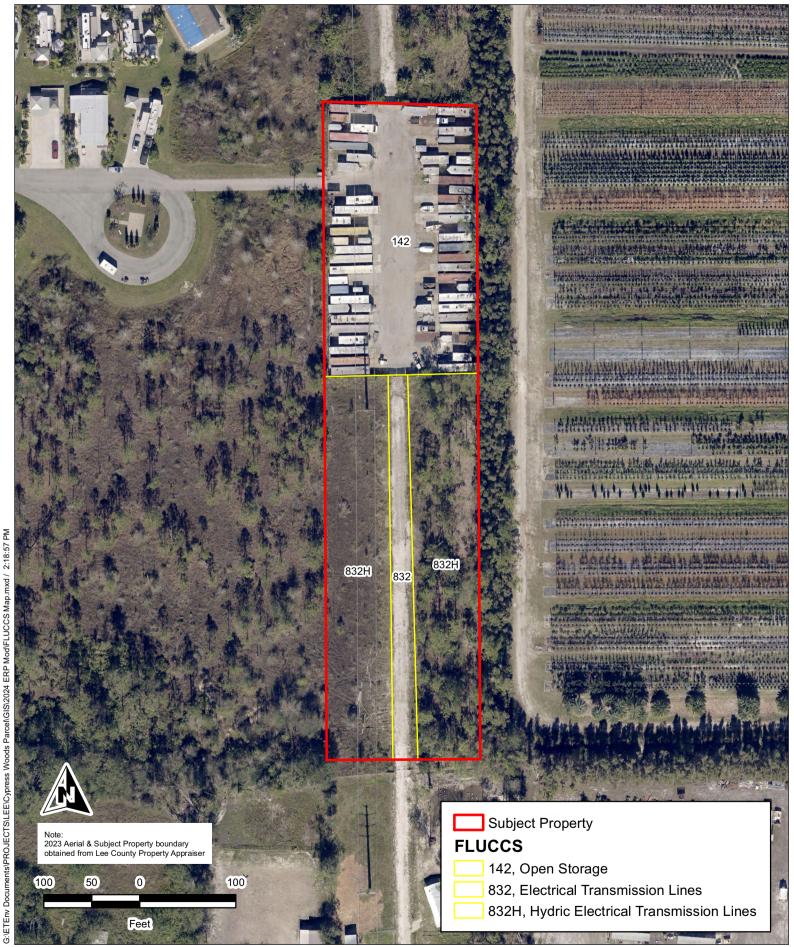

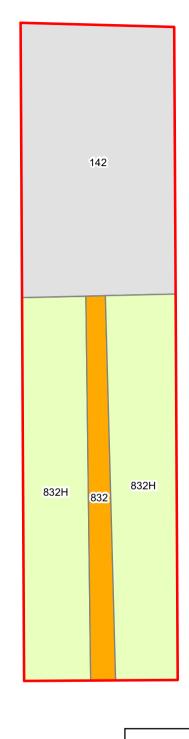

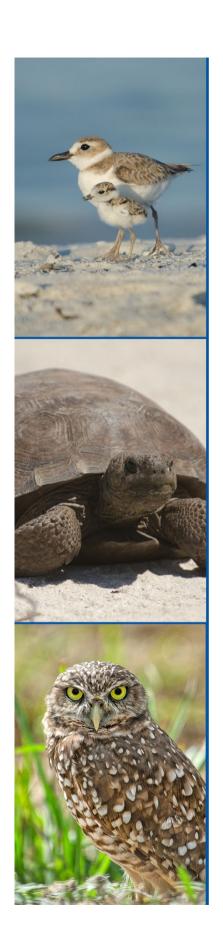

1.0 INTRODUCTION

Earth Tech Environmental (ETE) conducted a search for listed species on the property referred to as Cypress Woods (Subject Property). This assessment was conducted by ETE January 23rd, 2024, to evaluate the Subject Property for the potential presence of listed species of concern based on the determined Florida Land Use Cover and Forms Classification System (FLUCCS) vegetation.

2.0 PROPERTY LOCATION

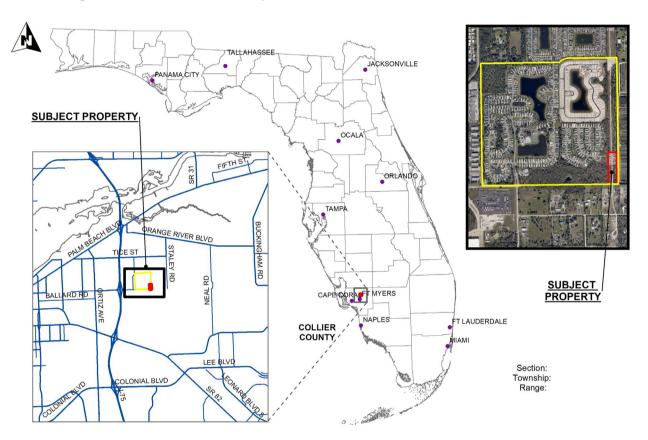


Figure 1. Site Location Map

The Subject Property for this report consists of a portion of a single parcel (Strap # 11-44-25-05-0000K.00CE). The Subject Property is the southern portion of the FPL easement that bisects the Cypress Woods RV Resort development north of Luckett Road and east of I-75 in Lee County, Florida. Based on the boundary linework provided to ETE by the planner the Subject Property totals approximately 2.51 acres. See Figure 1 below for a location map.

3.0 SPECIES SURVEY MATERIALS AND METHODS

The species survey was conducted in accordance with the Lee County Administrative Code AC-13-10, specifically using the Endangered Species Survey Methodology (ESSM) as outlined by Southern Biomes and approved by Lee County in accordance with AC-13-10. As outlined in the methodology, existing vegetation communities or land uses on the Subject Property were delineated on the most recent aerial photograph available (Lee County 2023) using the Florida Land Use, Cover and Forms Classification System (FLUCCS). FLUCCS mapping for this property is detailed below in Figures 3 & 4. The resulting FLUCCS codes

were cross-referenced with a list of protected plant and animal species. The lists were obtained from two agency publications:

- "Florida's Endangered Species, Threatened Species & Species of Special Concern-Official Lists", December 2022.
- * "Notes on Florida's Endangered and Threatened Plants", Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services, 2010.

In the field, each FLUCCS community is searched for listed species or signs of listed species. This is accomplished using a series of pedestrian transects throughout each vegetation community (see Figure 5). If necessary, transect integrity is maintained using a handheld GPS in track mode. At least 80% of each survey area was covered in this way. Signs or sightings of all species are recorded, and any associated burrows, dens, or cavities are flagged in the field and marked by GPS.

Based on the habitat types found on the Subject Property (see Table 3), particular attention was paid to the presence or absence of Big Cypress fox squirrel, gopher tortoise, and Florida bonneted bat. The presence or absence of listed plant species such as wild pine, twisted air plants, and butterfly orchids were also considered.

Approximately one (1) man-hours were logged on the Subject Property during this species survey (see Table 1).

4.0 EXISTING SITE CONDITIONS

Temperatures during the fieldwork for this survey were in the mid 70's with partly cloudy skies.

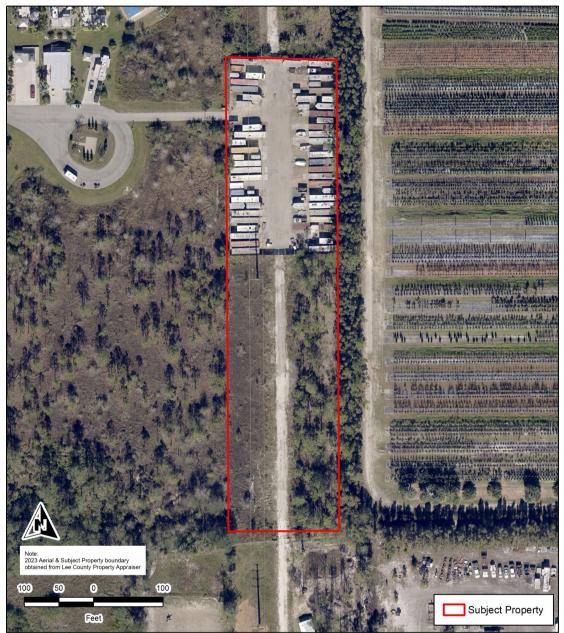


Figure 2. Aerial Map

The Subject Property consists of a utility easement that runs north-south in the southern portion, and an open storage area in the northern portion. Access to the open storage area is from the Cypress Woods RV Resort to the west, and from the north and south along the utility easement. A Conservation Easement (CE) runs north-south just west of the Subject Property in association with (SFWMD Permit #36-02960-S. See Figure 2 for an aerial map. The Subject Property has the following surrounding land uses:

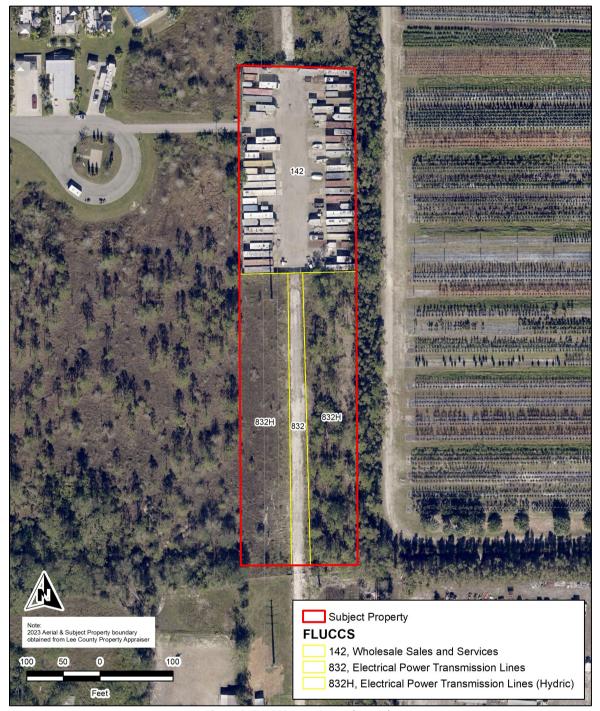
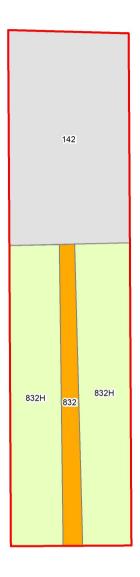


Figure 3. FLUCCS Mapping with Aerial





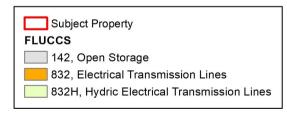


Figure 4. FLUCCS Mapping without Aerial

Listed below are the FLUCCS communities identified on the site. The community descriptions correspond to the mappings on the FLUCCS maps below (Figures 3 and 4). See Florida Land Use, Cover and Forms Classification System (Department of Transportation, Surveying & Mapping Geographic Mapping Section, 1999) for definitions.

The Florida Invasive Species Council's (FISC) list of invasive species contains Category 1 and Category II species that may be found on the Subject Property. Category 1 species are invasive exotics that are altering native plant communities by displacing native species, changing community structures or ecological functions, or hybridizing with natives (FISC). Category II species are invasive exotics that are increasing in abundance or frequency but have not yet altered Florida plant communities (FISC). A significant factor in mapping vegetative associations and local habitats is the invasion of these species such as Brazilian

pepper, earleaf acacia, melaleuca, and Caesarweed. Levels of exotic density were mapped by using field observations and photo interpretation as shown in Figure 3. Modifiers, or "E" designators, are appended to the FLUCCS codes to indicate the approximate density of exotics in the canopy and/or sub-canopy.

FLUCCS DESCRIPTIONS

* = exotic species

FLUCCS 142, Open Storage

This community comprises the north portion of the Subject Property and is the current open storage area for the Cypress Woods community. The area contains no existing vegetation.

FLUCCS 832, Electrical Transmission Lines

This community is comprised of the access road that runs down the center of the FPL easement. It is a limerock road with little or no vegetation.

FLUCCS 832H, Hydric Electrical Transmission Lines

This community comprises the remainder of the FPL easement, on either side of the central lime rock access road. The western side of the FPL easement has little or no canopy vegetation. Canopy vegetation on the east side the easement consists predominantly of *earleaf acacia (*Acacia auriculiformis*), *melaleuca, (*Melaleuca quinquenervia*), slash pine (*Pinus elliottii*), and cabbage palm (*Sabal palmetto*). Mid-story vegetation consists of occasional wax myrtle (*Myrica cerifera*), *earleaf acacia, *Brazilian pepper (*Schinus terebinthifolia*), and *melaleuca. Groundcover on both sides consists of various obligate sedge spp., various obligate grasses, broom sedge (*Andropogon virginicus*), dogfennel (*Eupatorium capillifolium*), and tickseed (*Corepsis spp.*).

5.0 RESULTS

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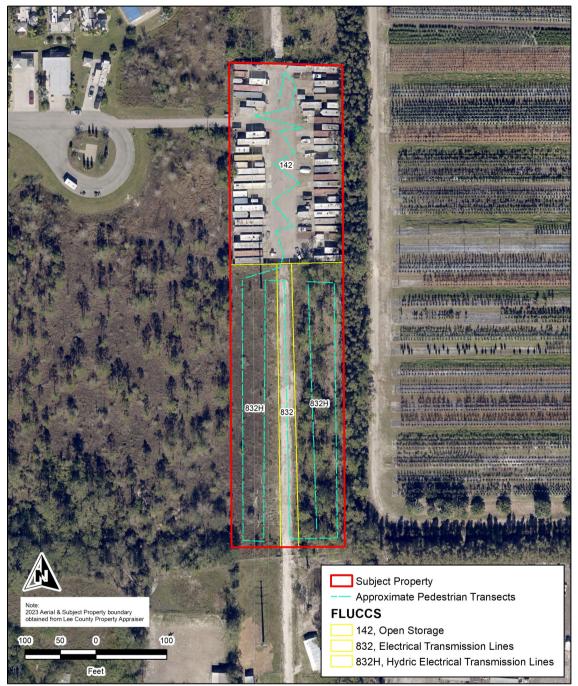


Figure 5. Transect Map & Field Results

All relevant species observed on the Subject Property are detailed in Table 3 and any protected species observed are specifically noted. See Figure 5 below for transect and field results.

No listed species or signs of listed species (i.e. cavities, nests, burrows, etc.) utilizing the Subject Property were identified. The Subject Property does have community types in which additional protected species could be utilized for foraging purposes. During permitting, the following protected species concerns may be raised by the agencies:

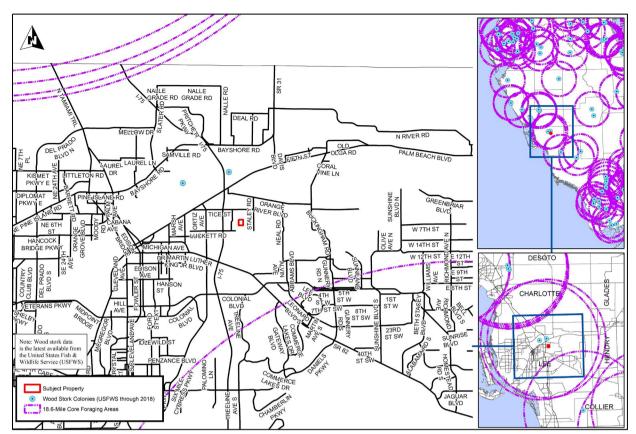


Figure 6. Wood Stork Foraging Information

Wood Stork (Mycteria americana)

The Subject Property falls within the core foraging area (estimated at 18.60 miles) of at least two (2) known wood stork colonies in Lee County (see Figure 6). Due to the lack of suitable nesting trees on the property and the proximity to the two known colonies, wood stork nesting is highly unlikely. The property consists of a relatively dense canopy with little to no standing water for extended periods of time for foraging purposes. Technical assistance from USFWS will likely not be required for wood stork.

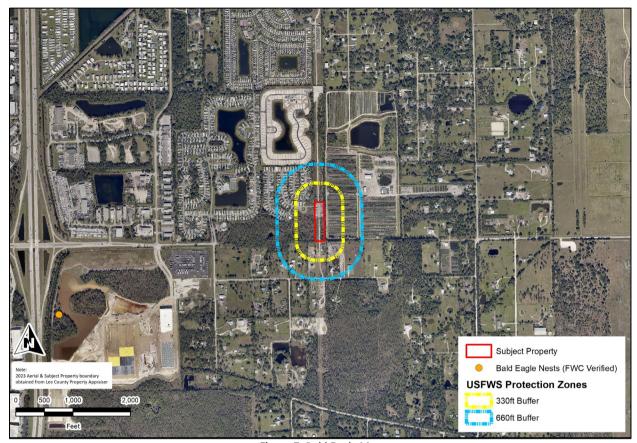


Figure 7. Bald Eagle Map

Bald Eagle (Haliaeetus leucocephalus)

The Subject Property does not fall within the 330-ffet or 660-feet USFWS Protection Zones of any FWC-documented bald eagle nest (see Figure 7). Technical assistance from USDWS will likely not be necessary for bald eagle.

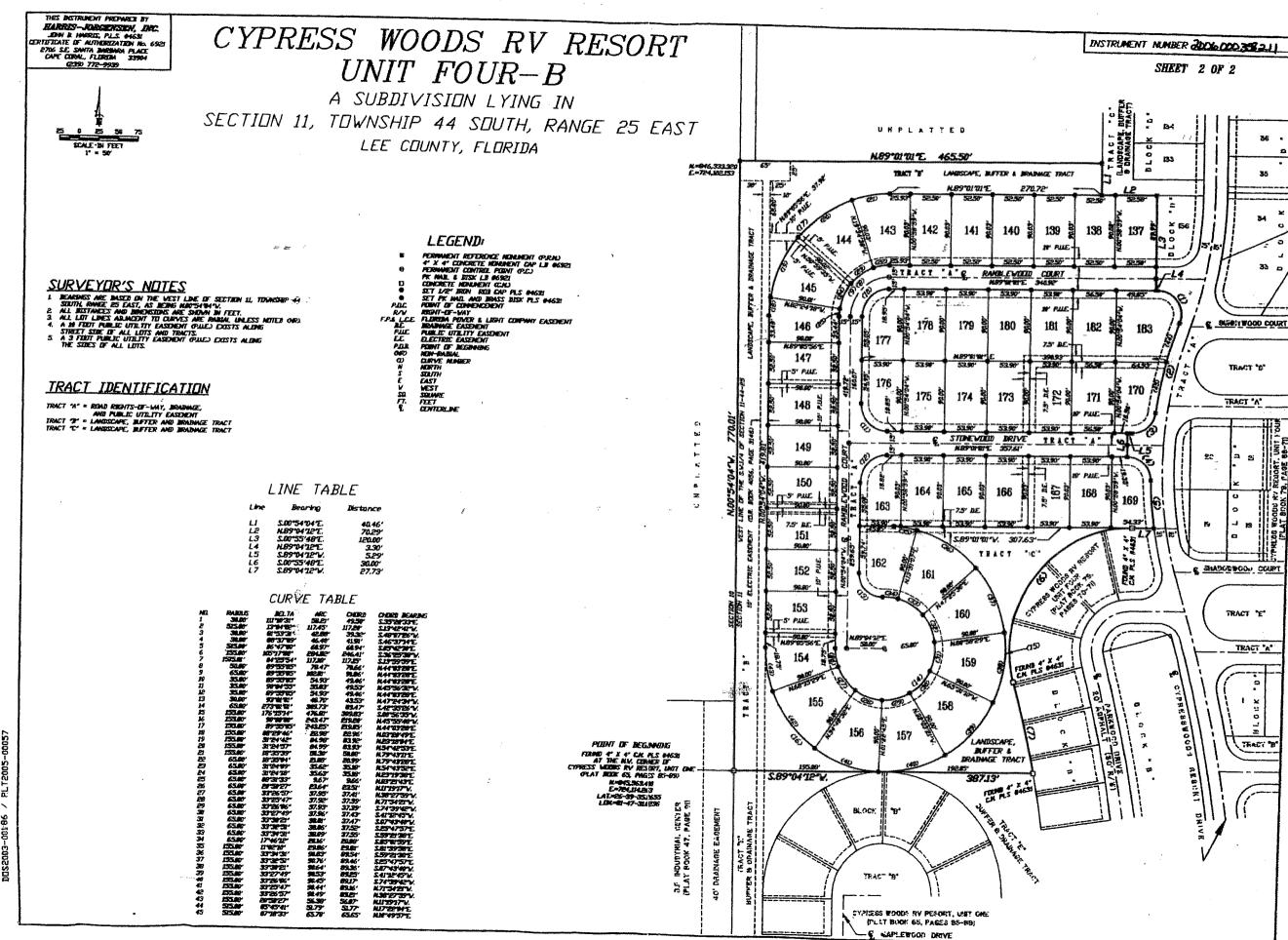

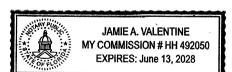
