Dear Ms. Harris,

In accordance with the provisions of F.S. Chapter 163.3187(1), this submission package constitutes the adoption of a Small-Scale Comprehensive Plan Amendment known locally as CPA2024-00014, Surf Style. The adopted amendment is being submitted through the small-scale review process as described in F.S. Chapter 163.3187(1). The amendment is as follows:

CPA2024-00014, Surf Style:

- Amend Map 1-A, Future Land Use, to redesignate a 0.60-acre portion of the subject properties to Urban Community from Suburban
- Amend Map 1-C, Mixed Use Overlay, to add the entire property to the Mixed-Use Overlay (MUO).

The Local Planning Agency held a public meeting for the plan amendment on July 28, 2025. The Board of County Commissioners voted to transmit the amendment on September 3, 2025.

This small-scale amendment to the Lee Plan consists of ± 1.76 acres and is the first small-scale amendment processed by Lee County this calendar year. The cumulative total number of acres for small scale amendments Lee County has approved during the 2025 calendar year is ± 1.76 acres.

The adopted small-scale comprehensive plan amendment is not within an area of critical state concern, nor does it involve a site within a rural area of critical economic concern.
